



Getting a job in the Aspen Point Program

Westcoast Energy Inc. (Westcoast), an Enbridge company, is moving forward with the construction of the Aspen Point Program (Project), an expansion of the northern section of the Westcoast natural gas pipeline system. The Project is designed to meet regional demand for natural gas and to support LNG exports.

The Project includes the installation of pipeline segments, electric-powered compressor stations, powerlines, a switch station and substations, and modifications to existing facilities. To complete the various components of the Project, Westcoast has hired general contractors, who will then be recruiting local workers and businesses for construction roles.
